Each table will consist of six adults and two club members so that the event attendees learn about our club members in a unique setting.

About the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Big Bend

The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Big Bend's mission is to inspire and enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring and responsible citizens.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Big Bend (BGCBB) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that serves the needs of hundreds of children and teenagers in the Big Bend area. BGCBB provides a positive and safe environment and a compelling alternative to drugs, crime and gang involvement. Children and teenagers across the Big Bend area are able to take advantage of the organization's youth development programs.

BGCBB never turns a child away because of past trouble with the law or because of a family's inability to pay; the organization has limited scholarship opportunities, provided on a first-come first-serve basis, that allow families with restricted incomes to benefit from our programs. With over 850 registered members, BGCBB impacts approximately 275 every day after school and all day, Monday through Friday, during the summer. BGCBB's youth development programs have five core focus areas: Character and Leadership Development – Education and Career Development – Health and Life Skills – The Arts - Sports, Fitness and Recreation. BGCBB is creating Great Futures, not only for its members, but for the Big Bend community as a whole. As BGCBB members grow into adults, they will become community leaders and will be better able to make key decisions because of their upbringing in the Boys & Girls Clubs.
